Professor of Chemical and Environmental Science and Engineering at the King Abdullah University of Science and Technology (KAUST), Saudi Arabia, since 2009. Her research focuses on polymer materials and membranes for sustainable separations and advanced methods of electron microscopy and synchrotron characterization. She is a Fellow of the World Academy of Sciences, a Fellow of the North American Membrane Society, an Honorary Member of the European Membrane Society. In 2023, she was named international L’Oreal-UNESCO for Women in Science laureate. Prior to joining KAUST, she led research on membranes for renewable energy at the Helmholtz Research Center in Germany. She holds a Doctor of Science in Chemistry from the University of Campinas, Brazil and was a Humboldt postdoctoral fellow in polymer science at the Johannes Gutenberg University, Mainz, Germany.
